Dr Jenny Pope has over 30 years' experience in the fields of environmental management and sustainability, in Western Australia and internationally. She is currently a member of the Environmental Protection Authority (EPA) of Western Australia (appointed November 2018), and Director of Western Australian consulting firm Integral Sustainability, which works with business and government to integrate sustainability objectives and strategies into decision-making processes and operational practices.

Jenny also holds a number of active academic positions; she is Extra-ordinary Associate Professor in Environmental Management at North-West University in South Africa and Fellow of the University of Cambridge Institute for Sustainability Leadership in the UK, where she teaches, researches and supervises Master's and PhD students. She is both a practitioner and an internationally-recognised scholar of impact assessment, with a focus on sustainability assessment, social impact assessment and strategic environmental assessment. She is an active member of the International Association for Impact Assessment, the Environmental Consultants' Association of WA and the Environment Institute of Australia and New Zealand.

Jenny has qualifications in chemical engineering and public policy and commenced her career as an environmental process engineer in the water and the oil and gas industries, before establishing her consultancy business and academic career.
