Andrew Beer is Executive Dean, Business, at the University of South Australia. Professor Beer gained his PhD from the ANU in 1990 and, since then, he has enjoyed working collaboratively in the academic, business and public sector arenas. Professor Beer is a Fellow of the UK's Academy of Social Sciences and a Fellow of the Regional Australia Institute. He has served on the College of Experts for the Australian Research Council and as Chair of the Regional Studies Association. Andrew had led many major research projects with his research interests encompassing a range of issues including the impacts of structural change within the economy, place-based policy, the strategies needed to sustain businesses in the regions, population dynamics and demography, the operation and functioning of Australia's housing markets, and the impacts of an ageing population. Andrew has published widely in academic journals and has authored several book.
