



CRC TiME Forum Speaker Biography – Prof. Carolyn Oldham

Carolyn is Professor of Environmental Engineering at UWA and has led research on environmental contaminants for the last 25 years. She was Project Leader in the WA Centre of Excellence for Sustainable Mine Lakes (2003-2008) and led a research team developing tools for the prediction of long-term water quality in acidic pit lakes. For the last decade, Carolyn has led projects under the CRC Water Sensitive Cities, on understanding water and nutrient pathways in urban areas with strong surface water – groundwater interactions. Through that work, she has created deep relationships with end users, and facilitated cross-disciplinary integration with planners, regulators and industries in the water sector.
