Dr Greg Davis is a Chief Research Scientist within CSIRO Land and Water located in Perth Western Australia. He has over 35 years' experience in developing innovative ways to investigate, monitor, and remediate the impacts of urban, industrial and mine site activities. This has spanned the disciplines of groundwater science, bioprocesses, environmental chemistry, geochemistry and modelling, with a deep research focus on understanding chemical behaviour in groundwater and soils. Dr Davis has partnered with a range of Government (e.g. Depart Environment; WA Dept of Water; WA Department of Water and Environmental Regulation; SA EPA; Mindarie Regional Council, Defence), industry (e.g., BP, Chevron, Rio Tinto, Dow Chemicals, Shell), and other organisations (e.g. CRC CARE). He was Chief Editor of the Journal of Contaminant Hydrology (2008-2014) and has published over 400 journal papers, conference papers and reports to industry, regulatory agencies and community groups, and has assisted with the development of state and national regulatory guidance.
