



### **CRC TiME Forum Speaker Biography – Prof. Peter Cook**

Peter Cook is Professor of Hydrogeology at Flinders University and Director of the National Centre for Groundwater Research and Training (NCGRT). One of Australia's foremost groundwater scientists, Professor Cook has more than 20 years' experience in groundwater research, spanning the fields of groundwater hydrology, ecohydrology, isotope hydrology, unsaturated zone flow process, and surface water – groundwater interaction. He has been working on hydrology of mining areas for more than 10 years, mostly within the Pilbara region of WA. He was the National Ground Water Association's Henry Darcy Distinguished Lecturer in Ground Water Science in 2009, the only time this honour has been awarded to a scientist from outside North America.
