With specialised knowledge in ecological restoration, Renee is an environmental scientist with over 15 years' experience across academia and the mining industry. Renee's on-ground knowledge, experience in restoration and understanding of the limitations and challenges currently faced by the industry, assists her to facilitate and coordinate the multi-disciplinary programs of work required to overcome some of the biggest barriers to ecological restoration. Recently Renee led the Western Australian Completion Criteria Project and is currently leading the development of the International Standards for Mine Site Restoration. In a joint appointment, Renee is the Program Director, Restoration for the Western Australian Biodiversity Science Institute, and the Centre Manager for the ARC Centre for Mine Site Restoration, Renee is an effective collaborator between industry and researchers to deliver leading restoration technologies for improved biodiversity outcomes. Renee has a PhD in biogeography and ex situ conservation.
