

CRC TiME Outstanding Student Award 2023

Nominations are now open for the inaugural CRC TiME Outstanding Student Award.

This award will recognise rigorous and unique postgraduate research that will support transformative change for positive mine closure and transition outcomes.

Nominations are open until 5pm AEDT on Friday 20 October 2023.

The winner will be announced at the CRC TiME Annual Forum dinner on 21 November in the Latrobe Valley, Victoria.

About the award

Examples of outstanding student activities may include:

- Exceptional engagement with regional communities leading to local benefits
- Actively incorporating First Nations Inclusion Principles
- Impressive stakeholder collaboration with the mining industry, mining engineering technology and services sector, community and/or government stakeholders

The award recipient will prize of \$1500 prize to spend on professional development.

Eligibility criteria

We encourage you to self-nominate. Nominations can also be submitted by partner organisations and CRC TiME employees.

All nominations must be received by 20 October 2023 and meet the following eligibility criteria:

1. Nominees must be CRC TiME HDR Top-Up Scholarship holders at the time of nomination.
2. Nominees can be from any field of research.

Assessment criteria

Nominations will be assessed based on the following criteria:

1. Statement setting out basis of case
2. Letters of support or similar evidence of outstanding contribution in areas of regional engagement, First Nations inclusion or stakeholder collaboration
3. Attachments supporting the case
