

CRC TiME Community Champion Award 2024

Nominations are now open for the CRC TiME Community Champion Award.

Nominations are open to CRC TiME partners, researchers, collaborators, and PhD Students. This includes individuals, groups, and organisations.

Nominations must be received by 5:00pm AWST, Friday 28 June 2024.

The award winner will be announced at the CRC TiME Annual Forum Dinner on Tuesday 20 August 2024 in Brisbane.

About the award

The Community Champion Award will celebrate community-centred approaches.

Examples of Community Champion activities include:

- Demonstrating a place-based approach to transition in your region
- Positively impacting the community's experience with transition
- Brought together a diverse range of people from the community to collaborate and work together towards transition
- Effectively engaged a cohort or group within your community, who had previously been disengaged with transition

The award recipient will receive a prize of \$1500 to spend on professional or community development.

Eligibility criteria

We encourage you or your organisation to self-nominate. Nominations can also be submitted by partner organisations. All nominations must meet the following eligibility criteria:

1. Nominees may be individuals, organisations or groups.

2. Nominations must be from CRC TiME partners, researchers, collaborators officially participating in CRC TiME projects, CRC TiME Steering Committee, Advisory or similar group, and PhD Students at the time of nomination.
3. These may be regional development, First Nations, mining, mining equipment, technology and services, research and other partner or collaborator organisations

Community Champion Award Assessment Criteria

Nominations will be assessed based on the following criteria:

1. Demonstrates an understanding of why a community-centred approach to transition is essential
2. Demonstrates a community-centred approach in practice through research, consultation and project development and/or delivery
3. Positive impact/s on people and communities within the region and/or First Nations group
