Nominations are now open for the inaugural CRC TiME Research Communication Award.

The award recognises individual/s that have demonstrated excellence in communicating and facilitating the use of their research.

Nominations are open to CRC TiME partners, researchers, collaborators, and PhD Students. This includes individuals, groups and organisations.

Nominations must be received by 5:00pm AWST, 28 June 2024.

The award winner will be announced at the CRC TiME Annual Forum Dinner on 20 August 2024 in Brisbane.

About the award

Research communication describes the way that information, knowledge, and data is shared and actively supports its use by stakeholders. Investing time and resources in communicating research to increase knowledge and skills and enable the use of research by people working to enable positive transitions in mine closure is highly valued by CRC TiME. This award recognises excellence in how CRC TiME research has been communicated. It could be communication involving individual or a combination of activities including:

- a conference presentation
- a video
- a workshop
- a training event
- a community briefing.
- a social media campaign

The award recipient will receive a prize of \$1500 to spend on professional or community development.

Eligibility criteria

We encourage you or your organisation to self-nominate. Nominations can also be submitted by partner organisations. All nominations must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. Nominees may be individuals, organisations or groups.
- 2. Nominations must be from CRC TiME partners, researchers, collaborators officially participating in CRC TiME projects, CRC TiME Steering Committee, Advisory or similar group, and PhD Students at the time of nomination.
- 3. These may be regional development, First Nations, mining, mining equipment, technology and services, research and other partner or collaborator organisations

Assessment criteria

Nominations will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- 1. Demonstrates an understanding and ability to communicate with end users about what is important to them.
- 2. Demonstrates intent and clarity of message, tone, and engagement in delivery.
- 3. Response, where demonstrable, to the communication.

How to nominate

- Nominations can be made on the CRC TiME website.
- Nominations must include the details of at least one referee. Please include this information in your nomination email.
- Evidence of approach and/or impact should be provided. Supporting documentation and attachments should be emailed to hello@crctime.com.au.
